









Massachusetts Advocacy Groups Unite for "100 Days of Harm" To Spotlight The Impact of Trump-Era Policies

The Massachusetts Immigration and Refugee Advocacy Coalition (MIRA), Health Care For All (HCFA), Reproductive Equity Now (REN), the Massachusetts Senior Action Council (MSAC) and the Disability Policy Consortium (DPC) have joined together in acknowledgement of the "100 Days of Harm" the Trump Administration has put Massachusetts residents through. Within the first 100 days in office, the Trump Administration has caused significant and harmful shifts in health care, immigration, reproductive rights, senior services and disability rights in Massachusetts and across the country.

Below is our list of 100 harms caused by the Trump Administration. This is not a comprehensive list due to the fact that the Trump Administration has far surpassed 100 harmful actions within its first 100 days.

- 1. Firing all staff in 7 of 12 Office of Civil Rights regional offices
- 2. Cutting funding to Department of Housing and Urban Development, affecting organizations that enforce anti-discrimination laws in housing
- 3. Removal of guidance for businesses to comply with the ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act)
- 4. Threats to funding for Developmental Disabilities Councils (under the Administration for Community Living)
- 5. Stripping "disability" language from federal grants
- 6. Threats to funding for Protection and Advocacy agencies which help protect rights of people with developmental disabilities (under the Administration for Community Living)
- 7. Disbanding disability policy offices under the Administration for Community Living which coordinates programs for people with disabilities who live at home in the community
- 8. Threats to school funding tied to diversity and anti-discrimination curriculum
- 9. Proposed shutdown of Department of Education including transferring special education programs to the Department of Health and Human Services
- 10. Removing staff from Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, preventing them from issuing formal guidance and rulemakings that protect disabled and pregnant workers
- 11. Threat to shift responsibility for emergency preparedness and disaster response to state governments, endangering vulnerable groups in states with fewer resources











- 12. Threats to defund Paralysis and Limb Loss Resource Centers
- 13. Defunding disability research programs such as autism research
- 14. Defunding the Institute of Museum and Library Services, funding museums and libraries across the US
- 15. Threats to funding for Indian Health Services
- 16. Freezing all new research grants at the US National Science Foundation
- 17. Dismantling Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)
- 18. Leaving World Health Organization (WHO)
- 19. Cutting National Institutes for Health (NIH) funding that ends critical medical research in rural communities
- 20. Reversing Biden administration policy that lowers costs of certain medications for Medicare recipients by disallowing negotiating with drug companies for certain types of drugs
- 21. Reduction to Veterans Administration (VA) staff
- 22. Threats to Medicaid both in Congress and aligned with administration's agenda, including paying for making 2017 tax cuts for the wealthy permanent
- 23. Removing recommendation of fluoride in water
- 24. Prohibiting federal funding for COVID-19 vaccine mandates in schools
- 25. Cuts to Medicaid Designated State Health Program (DSHP) that funds health related programs
- 26. Rescinding guidance on Medicaid role in helping with health related social needs (like housing, food access)
- 27. Weakening the Social Security Administration (SSA) which cause barriers to Medicare enrollment
- 28. Proposed rule change to shorten open enrollment period for health insurance marketplaces (like the Health Connector)
- 29. Proposal that could lower advanced premium tax credits (APTCs) (premium subsidies) and increase health insurance costs for marketplace plans
- 30. Executive Order to stop gender affirming care for children and adolescents under age 19
- 31. Proposal to prohibit gender affirming care as an Essential Health Benefit that plans would need to include
- 32. Rescinds orders that had called for LGBTQ+ people's health equity
- 33. Eliminating public health funding allocated during the COVID-19 public health emergency











- 34. Attacks on DEI programs that promote health equity & making federal funding contingent on not having DEI aspects to the programming
- 35. Staffing cuts at the Food & Drug Administration (FDA), potentially impacting food safety, medications/medical device and tobacco product oversight
- 36. Cuts to Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) program funding
- 37. Termination of NIH COVID-19 related research grants
- 38. Closing the Office of Long COVID Research and Practice
- 39. Cuts to medical research for people living with HIV/AIDS
- 40. Cuts to funding for medical research for Alzheimer's, cancer, and arthritis treatments
- 41. Reinstatement of "global gag rule" restricts U.S. funding to organizations providing, counseling for abortion services
- 42. Establishing a partnership between Department of Homeland Security and the Department Housing and Urban Development to identify households with mixed immigration status
- 43. Deporting without due process (expansion expedited removal, use of Alien Enemies Act)
- 44. Revoking student visas
- 45. Terminating Temporary Protected Status (TPS) programs preemptively
- 46. Allowing Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) to enter hospitals, schools and other previously protected spaces
- 47. Trying to end birthright citizenship
- 48. Involving Internal Revenue Service (IRS) in immigration enforcement
- 49. Creating a registry for immigrants targeting undocumented immigrants for immigrantion enforcement
- 50. Suspension of refugee resettlement program
- 51. Ending CHNV (humanitarian parole program for citizens of Cuba, Haiti, Nicaragua and Venezuela) and CBPOne programs/Terminating parole
- 52. Creating more obstacles for asylum seekers
- 53. Opening of new detention centers
- 54. Arresting immigrants based on their speech and political action
- 55. Increasing the number of partnership agreements between ICE and state and local law enforcement agencies
- 56. Pausing the processing of pending immigration applications filed by Cubans, Haitians, Nicaraguans, Venezuelans, and Ukrainians











- 57. Suspending the processing of green card applications for asylees and refugees
- 58. Using social media to vet noncitizens for their immigration applications
- 59. Executive Order targeting immigration lawyers
- 60. Shortening the period of assistance of cash and medical assistance programs for refugees
- 61. Detained noncitizens at Guantanamo Bay without due process
- 62. Threats to ban transgender people from enlisting or continuing to serve in US military
- 63. Cuts to Title X, the only federal program that funds family planning, eliminating support for Planned Parenthood
- 64. Dropped lawsuit seeking to show Idaho's abortion restrictions violate EMTALA (the longstanding federal law to provide emergency care regardles of the ability to pay)
- 65. Nominations of Anti-Abortion Extremists to Cabinet Positions
- 66. Layoffs of CDC Staff Tracking Maternal Deaths
- 67. Threatening to cut the Meals on Wheels program
- 68. Firing staff from offices that help coordinate benefits for people who have both Medicare and Medicaid
- 69. Proposal to eliminate Elder Falls Prevention Program
- 70. Proposal to defund Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program
- 71. Proposal to end funding for Elder Justice/Protective Services Program
- 72. Proposal to end funding for Aging & Disability Resource Centers
- 73. Proposal to eliminate Medicare State Health Insurance Assistance Programs that help people to navigate the Medicare enrollment process
- 74. Proposal to eliminate funding for Elder Rights Support Activities
- 75. Threats to imprison US Citizens in El Salvador's CECOT (Terrorism Confinement Center) prison
- 76. Eliminating grants for programs funded under the Older Americans Act (senior centers, caregiver supports)
- 77. Threats to eliminate funding for the Social Security Advisory Board
- 78. Elimination of the Administration for Community Living which helps seniors and people with disabilities remain independent by providing funding to local community service providers
- 79. Threats to funding for programs that promote seniors and people with disabilities ability to live independently in their communities including Centers for Independent Living and Agencies on Aging











- 80. Shutting down AmeriCorps volunteer program
- 81. Proposed cuts to SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)
- 82. Freezing funds to FEMA (Federal Emergency Management Agency)
- 83. Removal of critical information on government websites on a variety of topics including health, reproductive health, accessibility for people with disabilities and more
- 84. Deportation of US citizen child with cancer
- 85. Proposal to rescind the ability for Deferred Action Childhood arrivals to get health insurance through the marketplaces
- 86. Declaring by Executive Order only recognizing "two sexes, male and female" cross-cutting implications for non-binary people
- 87. Layoffs of CDC staff at the National Center for HIV, Viral Hepatitis, STD, and Tuberculosis Prevention
- 88. Layoffs of staff at CDCs Injury Center
- 89. Layoffs of staff at the National Center for Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion
- 90. Trump's proposed tariffs could raise prescription drug prices
- 91. Eliminating the health equity branch of the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases
- 92. Eliminating The Office of Health Equity
- 93. Threat of COVID-19 vaccine removal from list of vaccines recommended for children
- 94. Removes previous guidance about protecting privacy for reproductive health care
- 95. Stops efforts to advance reproductive health access for patients enrolled in Medicaid
- 96. Removing guidance allowing HIPAA to apply to gender-affirming care-related data
- 97. Removing guidance that protects people with gender dysphoria from being denied medically necessary care
- 98. Weakening legal protections for non-binary, trans and intersex people
- 99. Rescinds Executive Order requiring all federal agencies to have language access plans for people with Limited English Proficiency
- 100. Executive Order threatening to withhold federal funding for "sanctuary" cities and states
